Mounting:

- 1. Disassemble the original side plastics.
- 2. Remove the M6 and M10 bolts in the engine and motorcycle frame on the left side.
- 3. Mount the steel adapter (ID.1) on the motorcycle frame according to the attached photo below. For this assembly, use an M6x60mm screw (ID.6) with an M6 washer (ID.12) and a duralumin roller (ID.3), insert the duralumin roller under the steel adapter.
- 4. Use the original screw in the front upper part of the adapter.
- 5. Remove the M6 and M10 bolts in the engine and motorcycle frame on the right side.
- 6. In the front lower part of the adapter on the left side, push a steel rod (ID.13) through the frame.
- 7. Take the steel adapter for the right side (ID.1) and install it in the same way as on the left side.
- 8. Thread duralumin washers (ID.4) onto the steel rod in the lower part of both adapters and secure with nuts (ID.9) and M10 washers (ID.10). Dural washers belong under steel adapters.
- 9. Check and tighten everything, you can refit the side plastics.
- 10. Now start assembling the mount for the left slider. Mount the duralumin adapter under the slider (ID.2) on the steel adapter with a screw (ID.5) with a washer (ID.11).
- 11. Place the slider and fasten the screws (ID.7).
- 12. Insert the cover into the slider and fasten the screws (ID.8)
- 13. Mounting the slider on the right side is the same as mounting the left slider.



Warning - on the threads of the screws is recommended to use premium adhesive moderate (blue color).
